

# School Fundraising Quick Guide

**Host a School Fundraiser! Get your school community spirit lit for a good cause with one of our creative fundraising ideas!**

- ① **Bake Sale:** Have your own Great Australian Bake Off and ask a few keen bakers in your school community to cook up sweets and goodies to sell at a cake stall.
- ② **Host a Mother's Day breakfast:** During the week of Mother's Day, why not host a fun, pink-themed breakfast and collect donations for breast and/or ovarian cancer research. Think berry smoothies, pink velvet pancakes... the possibilities are endless!
- ③ **Host a sports day fundraiser:** Encourage your students to get active for breast and ovarian cancer research by organising a sports day fundraiser. It's time to dust off the hula hoops and tug of war ropes!
- ④ **Get pink on casual clothes day:** Host a pink-themed casual clothes day to raise awareness and funds with a gold coin donation.
- ⑤ **Host a Dance:** Get your dancing shoes on! Organise and invite your students to a school dance with entry fees contributing to your Mother's Day Classic fundraising efforts.
- ⑥ **Get competitive with a walk/run challenge:** Encourage healthy competition amongst students by getting them to set themselves a distance goal in the lead up to Mother's Day and pledge support. You can also measure your kilometers on the Mother's Day Classic dashboard.
